5. Does 1 year and under 2 years, milking, born between Aug. 1 and July 31.
6. Does 2 years and under 3 years, born between Aug. 1 and July 31.
7. Does 3 years and under 5 years, born between Aug. 1 and July 31.
8. Does 5 years and over.
9. Breeding Buck under 1 year.
