

GENERAL FAIR RULES AND REGULATIONS

I. STALLS AND PENS

- 1. Stalls will be assigned by the Superintendent; there will be no exceptions.
- 2. No private stalls or pens will be allowed. All exhibitors must use the county-owned stalls assigned to them.
- 3. No exhibitor may use another stall for storage, unless permission is granted by the Superintendent and the Fair Management together.
- 4. Absolutely no straw for bedding in stalls. Wood chips and peat moss may be used in stalls.
- 5. All stalls must be cleaned. If stalls do not meet superintendents' approval upon inspection, exhibitor will be contacted.

II. CONCESSIONS AND PRIVILEGES

- 1. Permits in this department are issued only by the Fair Manager.
- 2. The Fair Manager invites proposals for concessions and will be pleased to give information to all interested parties.
- 3. For reasons, satisfactory to himself, the Fair Manager shall reserve the right to cancel at any time all contracts made with concessionaires.
- 4. Each concessionaire must confine himself to the place assigned to him. Failure to do so will subject him to forfeiture without reimbursement.

III. FAIR PURCHASES

All purchases must have prior approval by Fair Manager.

IV. CAMPERS & UTILITY VEHICLES

1. Generators turned off between 10 PM and 6 AM

- 2. Only Fair Staff will be authorized to use utility vehicles on the grounds. Ex: ATV's, Golf Carts, Gators, etc.
