Razzle Dazzle Race

- 9 - 14.....\$20/Added Money \$200
- 15 - 18.....\$20/Added Money \$200
- 19 & over.....\$20/Added Money \$200

***Razzle-Dazzle Race – On straight-away only. Start at finish line at walk, trot to marker at curve, trot to barrel on straight-away, lop / run across finish line.

Water Race

- 9 - 14.....\$20/Added Money \$200
- 15 - 18.....\$20/Added Money \$200
- 19 & over.....\$20/Added Money \$200

***Water Race – Start at finish line with cup of water as given by race committee, ride up track, around barrel, and

back to finish line. First one across finish line with water to pour out for judge wins. Cup must be intact.

Rescue Race\$20/Added Money \$200

***Must have at least one partner under 14. One mounted rider starts at finish line, picks up their partner at the designated place and both ride double to cross the finish line.

ALL contestants are required to wear helmets and boots to enter. All bits are required have a shank and chain curb strap. Race committee reserve the right to limit the number of racers at a time.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

RODEO AND TRACK EVENTS

1. The Officers of the Association will see that these rules are strictly enforced.
2. All rodeo entries must be made with the CPRA Secretary.
3. The management reserves the right to make any necessary changes.
4. The management assumes no responsibility for injuries to contestants.
5. The County will not assume any liability for injuries to persons who violate the rules of the grounds. Spectators are prohibited from crossing the track during any event. We respectfully ask the cooperation of the attendants in enforcing this rule and thus preventing accidents.
6. **TRACK EVENTS** Any participant lodging a protest must first deposit \$25.00 cash or certified check with the Secretary of the Lincoln County Fair. This sum will be forfeited if the protest is not sustained. Protests must be signed by the protestant and will be received only on the day of judging. All protests must be referred to the Judges of the particular event or division.
7. All Rodeo complaints shall be directed through the CPRA office.
8. The management assumes no responsibility for accidents or injury to contestants or stock, and each participant, by the act of participation, waives all claims against the management for any injuries they or their stock sustain. In the event that an animal dies, the owners are responsible for the disposal of the animal. Otherwise, they will be charged a minimum fee of \$125.00 for the removal and disposal of the animal.
9. The management reserves the right to withdraw any contestant's name and entry for violation of any of the rules of the show or judges. All contestants to give assistance when requested to do so by officials of rodeo.
10. At this contest the management proposes to run a speedy program and each contestant is required to lend assistance in the matter of keeping the program moving and up to the standards set by the management.
11. All contests must have at least three contestants to start unless otherwise specified. Entrance fee on all contests, payable when entrance in contest is made. All entrance fees added to purse.
12. All autos must be parked in space reserved for parking. This will be enforced no exception. Parking will be directed by police. No change for parking. Contestants and exhibitors vehicles will absolutely not be permitted to park in front of box stalls except while loading or unloading. This will be strictly enforced.
13. Contest program subject to change at the discretion of Fair Management.
14. Lincoln County will not be responsible for any accidents.
