

## DEPARTMENT 3 – CROPS

1. All products competing in this department must have been grown in Lincoln County by the exhibitor during the current calendar year, except threshed samples of grain from the prior calendar year. Proof of ownership may be required even to the point of inspection by a Fair board representative.
2. All articles in farm exhibits will be permitted to show in open classes.
3. Individual entries in Club exhibits will not be considered for general farm display unless they are grouped together and marked as such.
4. Must designate dry land or irrigated.
5. **For additional rules see entry of exhibits located at the beginning of the open class section of the fair book.**

### DIVISION A - AGRICULTURE DISPLAYS

#### A-1 - Ag Displays

##### Class

1. Agriculture Display - Best All Around Farm, Garden or Farm and Garden combination display.

Awards will be based on a point system as follows:

Quality points to be awarded by multiplying the placing times the number in the class.

1st place, 4x number in class.

2nd place, 3x number in class.

3rd place, 2x number in class.

Each entry judged and not placing will receive 1 point. Displays should be neat and attractive. In case of tie, neatness and general attractiveness will be considered.

2. Display of Sheaves & Bundles mounted on panel - not less than 1-inch bundles. To be judged 50 pts. on educational value (identification, adaptation, etc.), 25 pts. attractiveness and 25 pts. on variety.

7. 2 gallons Red Millet
8. 2 qts. Sweet Clover Seed
9. 2 qts. Any Grass Seed
10. 2 gallons Beans any variety
11. 5 heads Coes
12. 5 heads any named Hybrid Grain Sorghum
13. 5 heads any other Sorghum
14. 2 heads Sunflower (current crop year)
15. 2 heads Black Oil Sunflower (previous crop)
16. 2 heads Striped Confection Sunflower (previous crop)
17. 2 gallons any other Small Grain

**A-3 - Sheaves and Bundles**

A sheaf shall be 3" in diameter. A bundle shall be 5" in diameter. All sheaves and bundles shall be mounted on a panel.

1. 1 sheaf Yellow or White Clover for seed.
2. 1 sheaf Yellow or White Clover for hay.
3. 1 sheaf Alfalfa for seed or hay.
4. 1 sheaf Bearded Wheat.
5. 1 sheaf Rye.
6. 1 sheaf Barley or Oats - Grain
7. 1 sheaf Barley or Oats - Hay
8. 1 sheaf Proso Millet.
9. 1 sheaf White Wonder Millet.
10. 1 sheaf any other Millet.
11. 1 sheaf of Tall Crested or Intermediate Wheat Grass.
12. 1 sheaf Sand Love Grass.
13. 1 sheaf Grama Grass.
14. 1 sheaf Blue Stem Grass.
15. 1 sheaf Rice Grass.
16. 1 sheaf any other variety Grass.
17. 1 bundle Yellow Dent Corn (6 stalks).
18. 1 bundle Hybrid Corn (6 stalks).
19. 1 bundle any other variety Corn (6 stalks).
20. 1 bundle Alfalfa.
21. 1 bundle Cane, Coes, Sorghum or Sudan.
22. 1 bundle Millet.
