## **DIVISION K - 4-H HERDSMANSHIP**

\$75 will be presented to the 4-H club that best demonstrates their herdsmanship abilities in all of the following: beef, dairy, sheep, swine, horse, goat, rabbit and poultry.

Factors to be considered in judging will be:

- 1. Completion of livestock exhibit cards.
- 2. Cleanliness of animal's stalls or pens.
- 3. Attractiveness of club display. Signs identifying clubs are required.
- 4. Attitude of club members, leaders, and parents, including cooperation and sportsmanship.
- 5. Proper care of animals, including disposal of waste materials and manure. Manure boxes or dumping areas for waste materials must be dumped at the appropriate location (check with your superintendent).
- 6. Neatness and cleanliness of feed and watering utensils, and prompt removal of utensils when not in use. Pitchforks will not be allowed in aisles except while feeding.
- 7. The Herdsmanship contest will start at 8 a.m., Tuesday of the fair, and conclude at 12:00 noon, Saturday of the fair. Displays must be ready for inspection at any time between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., during the time the contest is in progress.
- 8. The Herdsmanship award will be presented at the 4-H Achievement Program in October.
