Razzle Dazzle Race~On straight-away only. Start at finish line at walk, trot to marker at curve, trot to barrel on straight-away, lope/run across finish line.

Water Race~Start at finish line with cup of water as given by race committee, ride up track, around barrel, and back to finish line. First one across finish line with water to pour out for judge wins. Cup must be intact.

Musical Chairs~Riders start mounted and ride in clockwise circle when music starts. When music stops, riders dismount and stand where designed, keeping ahold of the horse's reins. The rider(s) without a designated stand(s) is out and exits the arena. Riders re-mount and continue in clockwise manner when music plays. Last rider to stand on the designed spot wins. Race judge(s) call who was last on the stand and helps kids re-mount if needed. Riders must stay outside the circle and always keep a clockwise pattern unless standing still.

ALL contestants are required to wear helmets and boots to enter. All bits are required to have a shank and chain curb strap. Race committee reserves the right to limit the number of racers at a time.

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS RODEO & TRACK EVENTS

- 1. The Officers of the Association will see that these rules are strictly enforced.
- 2. The management reserves the right to make any necessary changes.
- 3. The management assumes no responsibility for injuries to contestants.
- 4. The County will not assume any liability for injuries to persons who violate the rules of the grounds. Spectators are prohibited from crossing the track during any event. We respectfully ask the cooperation of all attendants in respecting this rule and thus preventing accidents.
- 5. TRACK EVENTS Any participant lodging a protest must first deposit \$25.00 cash or certified check with the Secretary of the Lincoln County Fair. This sum will be forfeited if the protest is not sustained. Protests must be signed by the protestant and will be received only on the day of judging. All protests must be referred to the Judges of the particular event or division.
- 6. The management assumes no responsibility for accidents or injury to contestants or stock, and each participant, by the act of participation, waives all claims against the management for any injuries they or their stock sustain. In the event that an animal dies, the owners are responsible for the disposal of the animal. Otherwise, they will be charged a minimum fee of \$125.00 for the removal and disposal of the animal.
- 7. The management reserves the right to withdraw any contestant's name and entry for violation of any of the rules of the show or per the judges. All contestants are to give assistance when re- quested to do so by officials of rodeo.
- 8. The management intends to run a speedy program and each 9. All contests must have at least three contestants to start unless otherwise specified. Entrance fee on all contests are payable when entrance in contest is made. All entrance fees are added to purse.
- 10. All autos must be parked in spaces reserved for parking. This will be enforced, no exception. Parking will be directed by police. There is no charge for parking. Contestants and exhibitors' vehicles will absolutely not be permitted to park in front of box stalls except while loading or unloading. This will be strictly enforced.
- 11. Contest program subject to change at the discretion of the Fair Management.
- 12. Lincoln County will not be responsible for any accidents.
